Parental Concerns

- **Food** Cove Valley uses professional standards when food is prepared for campers. Each meal is well balanced and designed to appeal to each age group of campers. If your child has special dietary concerns, we ask that you notify us two weeks before they arrive at camp and on their health card. We may ask for you to bring along some substitutes (i.e. soy milk for lactose intolerance).
- **Safety** Cove Valley takes the safety of each child very seriously. While accidents may happen, we try to limit the chance of serious injury in all we do. There is a nurse on grounds 24 hours a day as well as a doctor on call. There is a certified lifeguard at the pool and lake, and many of the staff have CPR and First Aid training. Staff that apply to work at camp are carefully screened to make sure that they are qualified to work with children and have the required PA/FBI background checks.

Visitors - Visitors are discouraged, must be approved by the administration, have very limited contact with the camper, and are never alone with any camper.

Registration Instructions

- 1. Complete one form per child.
- 2. Submit a registration form(s) plus \$20 non-refundable deposit per child per week to the camp office. (See Cancellation Policy)
- 3. About a month before your child's week, you will receive the Parent Pack through the mail or via a link in your email.
- 4. The Parent Pack will include:
 - list of what to bring and rules to remember
 - pick up and departure times
 - any release forms including the Health Authorization Form
 - \cdot other important information

Cancellation Policy

- \$20 deposit is non-refundable
- Before May 1, all except the deposit is refunded
- May 1-June 1, 50% except the deposit is refunded
- After June 1, no refund except for a medical emergency with a written notice from a qualified physician
- No shows or children sent home forfeit their refund

Electives

We will do our best to give everyone their first choice. The Eagles electives are more in-depth than the Blue Jays electives.

- Archery Learn basic techniques/skills for the sport with safety being a primary focus. Learn with re-curve and compound bows.
- **Chef** Experience the fun of preparing food, trying new recipes, and eating the end result. Space is limited.
- Crafts Bring your creativity and prepare to put it to good use as we create wonderful works of art.
- Drama Participate in dramatic skits. You will have center stage on the final night of camp to share your talents with the rest of camp.
- Fishing Spend the mornings fishing on Cove Valley's Lake Tranquility. You will learn all of the essentials about how to fish and will have the opportunity to put everything you learn into practice. All necessary equipment will be provided.
- Rocketry You will build and launch your own rocket. You may also bring a rocket from home to work on or show to everyone! Sports – A new sport awaits you every day! Possible sports include basketball, hockey, soccer, ultimate, football, volleyball, and more!
- Worship Team Lead worship for the camp as part of a team, as well as learn techniques for leading and selecting worship music. Bring your own instrument/s.
